### **A Few Points about JBER FAM CAMP & Black Spruce:**

- **STRICTLY ENFORCED 5 MPH Speed Limit**  
*Please watch for children at play throughout the area.*
- At Camp Ground main bath/laundry facilities, you will find:
  1. Maps of JBER
  2. Maps of Downtown
  3. Information from Outdoor Rec Outdoor Adventure Programs
  4. Freezer for ice (Honor System)
- Laundry and Showers are available, Please help by cleaning up after use. Do not leave laundry unattended, do not wash dishes, smoke or bring pets into the laundry or shower facilities.
- The playground is centrally located near the laundry facilities Bldg. 5968 at the FamCamp and bath house in Black Spruce. Operation of motorized vehicles within the playground is prohibited. Children under the age of 10 years old must be accompanied by an adult at all times. **Dogs are NOT allowed within the playground area.** Please exercise your pets on the lawns near the entrance.
- Maximum of 2 pets allowed per camp site. Pets are required to be on leash at all times and cannot be outside while you are away. The leash cannot be longer than 6ft. Dog droppings are a problem, please pick up and dispose of all animal waste immediately and properly. According to AFI 34-110, 3.12.3: Customers must clean up after their pets. Pets may not be left unattended in either CAMP GROUNDS for a period exceeding 2 hours.
- Bicycle helmets are required on base and in the campground at all times while riding bikes.
- **Quiet hours are 10:00PM to 07:00AM.** Operating of generators during these hours is restricted.
- No processing of wild game, cleaning or smoking of fish within the campground.
- For General Delivery of Mail, JBER-R, building 724 on Quartermaster Drive, Door 32 in the rear of the Post Office you can go and register M-F 8AM to 5PM or phone **907-384-0307**
- WIFI is NOT currently available at campground. For access go to the Warrior Zone, BX/PX food court, Arctic Oasis, Starbucks/Base Theater or Base Library.
- NO OPEN FIRES are allowed in the campground (i.e. a ring of rocks on the ground, etc...). Use only the grills provided or a commercially made personal fire kettle with legs. Please ensure cold ashes from the grills have been safely removed and placed in the dumpsters, **NOT in the woods.**

- Payment for extensions of your stay **must** be received no later than 1:00PM the day of your scheduled checkout to insure an uninterrupted stay in the site. If there is a waiting list for a FHU (Full Hook Up) sites, you may need to move to a Dry Camp to allow other patrons the opportunity to have a place to stay. There will be **NO** waiting list or reservations, first come first serve only. The number of days in a FHU will depend on the number of days and amount of patrons needing a campsite. Max number of days stay without a 24 hour break is 30 days. This can be waived by the camp host as long as we do not have folks waiting to get in to a FHU site. Your camp host will make every effort to accommodate the quest needs.

## **And Finally**

**Bears**, please report all bear sightings immediately to the camp host. If the camp host is not available, please call the Security Forces at (**907-384-0823**). Freezers placed outdoors have been damaged in the past, please keep them wiped clean of any food scent and locked if possible. No food or trash should be left outside. Please dispose of all trash in the dumpsters provided.

**Improperly stored garbage and food items are the largest attractions for the bears. They are not naturally attracted to humans – They just want to eat. JBER Wildlife Officers are “Federal Officers”; they monitor our campground for storage violations and will issue citations to Federal Court if necessary.**

**All campers leaving Fam Camp should ensure their site is as clean as or cleaner than when they arrived.**

## **Camp Travel Campground Rules**

1. Authorized patrons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an authorized patron 18 years or older.
2. No open fires, only authorized in areas will be in the BBQ grills in the camp area or personal grills.
3. JBER regulations concerning restrictions and transportations of weapons must be followed. Weapons are prohibited in the travel camp ground.
4. The consumption of any type of alcohol beverages by an individual under age of 21 is prohibited. Intoxicated individuals or rudeness will result in the eviction from the travel camp and possible actions by the Provost Marshall.
5. Leash pets at all times, clean up animal waste.
6. Patrons are responsible for the proper care and protection of all government property, facilities and equipment at all times. If damaged items are reported, appropriate action will be taken by the military security forces (S.F.). Damage to facilities and equipment occurring from other than normal fair wear and tear, as determined by the camp host/director, will be referred to the S.F.
7. Again, quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 08:00 AM; please respect your fellow campers.
8. Please do not disturb the natural resources in the camp ground area, this includes, but not limited to stripping bark, cutting limbs or chopping trees. Any obstructions that need to be cleared please contact the Camp Host.
9. No dumping of hazardous materials, oils etc...
10. Parents of children in the campground are responsible for their conduct and behavior at all times.
11. Always be on the lookout for wildlife in the area, report bears to camp host.
12. Authorized patrons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an authorized patron 18 years or older.
13. Be on the lookout for wildlife in the area, report bears to camp host.
