



ATV SAFETY



Learn the basics and safety operations for ATV riding in Alaska. Our experienced instructors will guide you through the proper driving techniques needed to ride through various terrain types in a controlled environment. Cost:

- ATV provided: \$50 per person (*\$25 off your first ATV Trip*)
- Personal ATV: FREE

Time: 5 - 9 p.m.

Age limit:

- 10 & up for riders
- 16 & up with a valid drivers license to drive

Requirements: Parents if you want your children less than 16 years of age to go through the class you must provide your own machine rated for the age of your child. A minimum of 4 must sign up for the training to take place.

Special Information

Must be able to perform physical activity of riding an ATV over off-road terrain.

Personal Gear Checklist:

- Boots that cover the ankle (*combat boots are fine*)
- Weather appropriate clothing
- Wet weather gear (*rain jacket/pants or issue Gore-Tex*)
- Eye protection and Balaclava
- PolyPro top and bottom (*issue is ok*)
- Canteen/hydration pack with water

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations and/or changes to an existing reservation must be made at least (3) days prior to the scheduled reservation for a 50% refund. Cancellations and/or changes within 3 days of pending reservation will forfeit all monies paid and receive no refund. The only exceptions to the cancellations policy is emergency military duty with written documentation from your supervisor or a written doctor's note.

Gear Provided:

- ATVs
- Helmets
- Reflective vests

Training Objectives:

- **Action:** Properly demonstrate and perform proper ATV driving techniques, cover and model use of and wearing/use of all safety gear and equipment and then conduct a movement to a specific location by ATVs using proper techniques.
- **Conditions:** In a group of up to 8 personnel, riders will undergo the ATV safety training in an area by ATV using demonstrated riding techniques while in a wilderness setting during daylight hours with the possibility of rain and mud.
- **Standards:** Safely complete the ATV certification course while wearing appropriate equipment and safely using the equipment.

Safety:

- If there is heavy rain that makes ATVing conditions dangerous in the areas of operation a secondary site will be selected if possible. If no location meets the safety requirements the trip will be canceled and rescheduled. Any person that shows up for the training without the appropriate clothing will not be allowed to go.
