



MATANUSKA GLACIER ICE CLIMB TRIPS



Traverse and scale the ice of the Matanuska Glacier and experience the awe of Alaska. Everyone will first undergo a safety class to include wearing of equipment, use of crampons, climbing techniques, route selection, use of ropes/equipment, self-arrests, and ice climbing. Personal Gear Checklist:

- Issue combat boots or mountaineering boots designed for crampons
- Weather appropriate clothing
- Wet weather gear (*rain jacket/pants or issue Goretex*)
- Change of socks (*wool preferred*)
- Gloves
- PolyPro top and bottom (*issue is ok*)
- Canteen/hydration pack with water
- Rucksack/back pack
- Camera in a zip lock bag
- Snacks (*we'll stop at Fred Meyers in Palmer for food, water, donuts, coffee, etc*)

Gear Provided:

- Ropes
- ATCs
- Anchors
- Ice Screws
- Crampons
- Mountain axes
- Ice tools
- Helmets
- Carabineers
- Webbing
- Harness

Special Information:

- Must be able to perform physical activity of hiking and climbing.

Safety:

- If there is heavy rain or excessive melt caused by high temperature that makes conditions dangerous in the areas of operation the trip will be canceled and rescheduled or refunded. Any person that shows up for the trip without the appropriate clothing will not be allowed to go.



Cancellation Policy

Cancellations and/or changes to an existing reservation must be made at least (3) days prior to the scheduled reservation for a 50% refund. Cancellations and/or changes within 3 days of pending reservation will forfeit all monies paid and receive no refund. The only exceptions to the cancellations policy is emergency military duty with written documentation from your supervisor or a written doctor's note.
