

WILLOW/SPENCER GLACIER SNOW MACHINE RIDE



This trip is designed to take riders on a guided trail ride through Willow/Spencer Glacier while enjoying views, as weather allows, of surrounding mountains. Participants can expect to be on the trails for anywhere from 4-6 hours which includes a break for lunch. Trail routes may vary based on weather conditions. Cost:

- Drivers: \$99 per person
- Rider: \$50 per person

Time: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Meet: OAP, Bldg. 7301

Age limit:

- 12 & up for riders
- 16 & up with a valid drivers license to drive

Safety:

- *If there is heavy snow fall that makes driving conditions dangerous or temperatures are colder greater than -12 for either ambient or initial wind chill in the areas of operation a secondary site will be selected if possible. If no location meets the safety requirements the trip will be canceled and rescheduled. Any person that shows up for the trip without the appropriate clothing, boots gloves, or gear will not be allowed to go.*

Gear Provided:

- Snowmachines
- Reflective Vests
- Helmets

Special Information:

Parents must understand this can be an extremely cold weather ride with no warm up sites on the trail and we will be covering in excess of 45 miles while riding with wind chills that could exceed -30. A minimum of 6 must sign up for the trip to go; a maximum of 10 drivers with 4 riders may attend.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations and/or changes to an existing reservation must be made at least (3) days prior to the scheduled reservation for a 50% refund. Cancellations and/or changes within 3 days of pending reservation will forfeit all monies paid and receive no refund. The only exceptions to the cancellations policy is emergency military duty with written documentation from your supervisor or a written doctor's note.

Personal Gear Checklist:

- Extreme cold weather boots (*rated for -50 degrees*)
- Extreme cold weather issue/civilian equivalent (*Gor-Tex and ECW system*)
- Change of clothes and socks (*wool preferred*)
- Arctic mittens, gloves & contact gloves, balaclava, neck gator & hat
- PolyPro top and bottom (*issue is fine*)
- Polar fleece (*issue is fine*)
- NO cotton clothing allowed. Clothing must meet and exceed the weather conditions. Plan on wind chills of - 30 or more
- Rucksack/backpack
- Camera in zip lock bag/go pro with protective case
- Snacks and water (*we will make a rest stop at Fred Meyer in Wasilla where items can be purchased*)
- Insulated thermos and sports drinks
