In this capacity, she was responsible for AFMC's largest Force Support Squadron with 715 personnel who manage all military and civilian personnel, manpower, education and training, Airman and Family Readiness, lodging, food service, fitness, child and youth development, recreation, mortuary affairs, and Honor Guard functions in support of the Air Forces's largest installation
