

Did you know... Cooper Landing

Cooper Landing straddles the Sterling Highway on the northern side of picturesque Kenai Lake, and although its population doesn't even breach 500 residents, the town is bustling and crowded during the fishing months. Fishing the famous Kenai River draws hundreds and is an amazing experience. Floating upriver in drift boats to catch rainbow trout or sockeye salmon is just as fun as being in a powerboat.

Fishing fever hits an all-time high at the Russian River Campground during the summer months, and fishermen stand shoulder-to-shoulder in what is referred to as "combat fishing." This combat fishing is so popular here that it demands a certain level of etiquette, which has inspired numerous newspaper articles. They serve as a reminder to fishermen of the manners needed in this crowded natural environment.

Proper etiquette is not the only concern of anglers in this region. In fact, bears are frequent visitors to the fishing action and campgrounds situated along the Kenai River. Fishermen are advised to keep a wary eye out when out fishing, lest you be fishing alongside a natural predator.

Cooper Landing offers a wide variety of comfortable accommodations, from lodging, restaurants, and other tourism services. Overnight options include cozy Alaskan B&Bs, rustic lodges, rental cabins, and some RV parks and campgrounds. This includes the Russian River Campground, which boasts over 80 sites for campers of all skill levels.

If you're seeking a more rural and naturalistic experience, however, you can rent a Forest Service Cabin in advance of your arrival at Cooper Landing. These cabins are remote and many require float plane transportation to reach.

Flight charters can be arranged in advance at Cooper Landing, as well. If flying to a remote cabin is too much, you can reach other rural cabins by hiking along the Resurrection Pass Trail or the Russian Lakes Trail.

If you're seeking a unique and rural Alaskan fishing adventure, Cooper Landing is certainly the place to be! Ready to start your next big adventure? Contact the JBER ITT office today by calling 753.2378 or by emailing AFTravelAlaska@gmail.com.
