





Fishing In Alaska: All You Need to Know to Fish

Fishing in Alaska is an exceptional and unforgettable experience, and there is no shortage of places to fish that are certain to captivate and inspire. With pristine glacial streams, exquisite crystal lakes, monumental seas, and bountiful amounts of fish, Alaska is one of the top fishing destinations in the world. So, if you're ready for some of the greatest fishing opportunities that the world has to offer, this state is the place to be!

Alaska is especially renowned for Pacific halibut and salmon, both of which are highly profitable exports from the state. The halibut market here in Alaska is one of the most remarkable in the world, with massive record-breaking halibut documented almost every year. While fishing for halibut is a deep-sea style of fishing, it is extremely popular amongst angling tourists. With a booming demand for halibut fishing trips, hundreds of charters are available to encourage prospective fishermen.



The Information, Tickets, and Travel office on JBER almost always has the capability to reach out to these charters, as well, and provide tickets for those who are interested. If you're interested, reach out to them and see what opportunities are available for a rare seafaring adventure with a delicious payoff.

As for salmon fishing, it is what Alaska is best known for when it comes to fishing. The methods of catching vary from lures, baits, flosses, snags, and dip-nets, with a variety of salmon can be caught here. There are five different species of Pacific salmon in Alaska: Chinook salmon (kings), Coho salmon (silvers), Sockeye salmon (reds), chum salmon (dogs), and pink salmon (humpies). Each of these species have different seasons for fishing and a unique flavor.

Kings usually are running from May to July, and are the largest variety of salmon, with a meaty and savory composition. Many consider it to be the best variety of salmon. Silvers run from July to September, and they

are known for having a more subtle flavoring compared to their pinker relatives. Reds run from June through early August, and they are known for having the most powerful taste and scent that is very recognizable. Dogs run from July through early August and are markedly smaller than their relatives, with a low fat content. Dogs are most commonly pursued for their roe (eggs), but they are still appetizing and delicious. Finally, humpies run from early July through early August, as well, and are lightly colored, very small, and are most often canned or smoked compared to other varieties of salmon.

To fish these pleasant fishes, there are numerous creeks and rivers throughout Anchorage and the surrounding areas that boast large salmon runs. If you want to fish for them, there are plenty of places, but they are often crowded, rainy, muddy, and rocky conditions that you'll have to brave. The Outdoor Recreation Center boasts rentable fishing equipment for this occasion and can provide maps and details for both amateur and experienced anglers.

Of course, if roughing it in the expansive and cold waters of Alaska for salmon or halibut isn't quite your style, but you still want to enjoy amazing Alaska fishing, there


are numerous lakes that you can boat on and fish for northern pike. There are no limits, unlike with halibut and salmon, on the amount of pike that you can fish in local lakes, since they are an invasive species. While pike are notably smaller than the more demanded salmon or halibut, they do taste wonderful when grilled over a fire in a buttery spice mixture.

Otter Lake on JBER, as well, is a great destination for prospective fishers. Boats are available for rent and cabins can be utilized for overnight stays, as well. To utilize Otter Lake, an iSportsman




recreational access permit is required, but it is worth it for the peaceful surroundings and plentiful pike fishing opportunities.

Alaska fishing license is required, and the Outdoor Recreation Center has many to provide. They are also offering king stamps for king salmon fishing this season. Additionally, if fishing isn't your choice of adventure, Outdoor Recreation also has numerous other summer activity rentals for you to choose from. If hiking, kayaking, camping, or simply getting out there and seeing the Last Frontier is your objective, be sure to contact the Outdoor Recreation Center.
