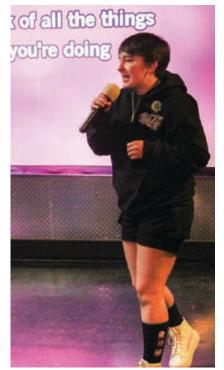

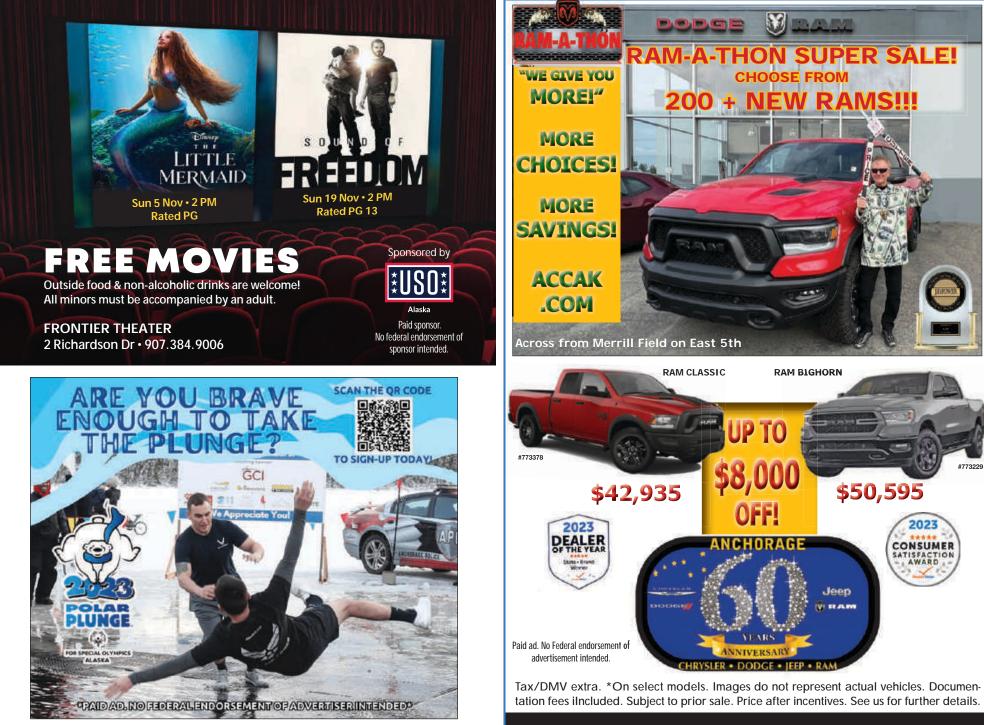

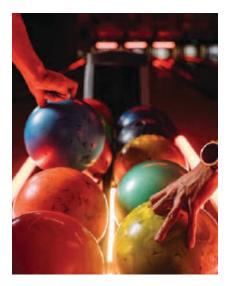

Taste of JBER

Since food is an important part of any holiday we reached out to our JBER community to share with us some of their favorite dishes. Here is a small sampling of the wide range of tastes on JBER.

Salmon Fried Rice

Regina W. received this recipe from a co-worker 25 years ago and has been preparing it ever since.

- 8 pieces of bacon, chopped
- •1 medium size onion, diced
- 1 6 to 8 ounce salmon filet, chopped
- 2 cups of cooked rice
- 4 to 5 tablespoons of soy sauce

Cut up about 8 pieces of bacon and fry real crispy, don't drain the grease (more is better). Add 1 chopped onion (make sure the bacon is crispy or the water from onions kills the bacon) and cook. When that is done, I spread it around the pan and place the chopped up salmon in the middle to cook. (I guess the amount of salmon is determined by how much you like. My husband, Roy, likes more bacon than salmon.) Mix it together and add 2 cups of cooked rice and soy sauce. If my bacon isn't real fatty I will add extra bacon grease.

Borscht Soup

Susie H. and her husband enjoy this Russian winter recipe.

- 1 (16 ounce) package of ground pork or beef, browned
- 3 medium size beets, peeled and shredded
- 3 carrots, peeled and shredded
- 4 medium size baking potatoes, peeled and cubed
- ¹/₂ medium head cabbage, shredded
- 1 cup diced tomatoes, drained
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 (6 ounce) can tomato paste
- 8¾ cups water, divided, or as needed
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 teaspoon white sugar, or to taste
- salt and pepper to taste
- ¹/₂ cup sour cream, for topping
- freshly chopped dill or
- parsley for garnish

1. Add 4 to 5 cups water to a big pot 2. Add beets and boil until soft.

- Remove, peel, and chop into cubes 3. Return beets to pot, add peeled
- and cubed potatoes
- 4. In a separate skillet cook meat, chopped onions, and tomato paste.
- 5. Once cooked, add mixture to pot. Bring to a boil and stir occasionally.
- 6. Add chopped cabbage and carrots and boil for 20 minutes or until soft.
- 7. Add one can of tomatoes and season with garlic, salt, pepper, dill, and sugar.
- 8. Boil on low, adding water or seasoning if needed.
- 9. Once veggies are soft, serve and enjoy!

Shepherd's Pie

Ally H. from Ireland, is reminded of her hometown when she prepares it for her husband's SFRG get together, "potluck style".

There really isn't a recipe per se, you measure with your heart.

I use a 9x9 pan. You need ground lamb, paprika, brown gravy powder, onion, garlic, mashed potatoes, peas, carrots chopped up, beef broth, ketchup and cheese.

The first thing you want to do is wash and peel around 10 big potatoes, depending on the size of your dish. On high heat, you then want to put them in a big pot and bring them to a roaring boil. You will know they're done when you can easily poke a knife or fork through it with no issues.

Whilst waiting for them to boil I season and cook my ground lamb on medium heat. Once cooked I drain my ground lamb, add in my vegetables, beef broth, brown gravy powder, and mix. Once the brown gravy, mixture has dissolved I add in a LOT of ketchup. The more ketchup, the better. Mix all of it together.

Mash your potatoes, add in milk, butter, salt and pepper. You want super creamy mash so don't be afraid to be generous with your milk and butter. Once you have everything prepared you want to fill up half of the pan with your ground lamb mixture, then fill up the rest of the pan with your mashed potato mixture and cover your mashed potatoes with sharp cheddar cheese.

Place your pan in the oven on high broil for 5-7 minutes and enjoy!

Let's Talk Turkey!

With Thanksgiving just weeks away we decided to "Talk Turkey" with JBER's very own chefs. We asked them to give us some insight into what makes for a delicious Thanksgiving meal. Here's a look into how Chef Eric and SFC Foley, who prepare thousands of meals a day, tackle JBER's Thanksgiving.

1. When planning the menu for the Thanksgiving meal, what do you have to take into consideration?

Chef Eric: Holiday meal planning can be a challenge no matter if you're cooking for 8 or 1,200. Know your audience, pick recipes that are going to provide that home-cooked comfort meal feel, and make sure to include any cultural and dietary needs of your guests.

SFC Foley: Amount of servings needed and the layout of where all the food will be during the serving times.

2. With such a diverse community and tastes on JBER, what foods do you believe will bring people together the most?

Chef Eric: As far as our Alaskan and JBER cultures, we have such a wide range of influences and cultures present here on the base that I would envision a Thanksgiving meal with dishes from the Pacific Rim all the way through the southern states. It would be an epic meal!

SFC Foley: All the traditionals! Roasted turkey, cranberry sauce, stuffing, and pumpkin pie.

3. What is a food that you think would make a great Thanksgiving meal addition, but isn't "mainstream"?

Chef Eric: I enjoy taking traditional dishes and giving them a modern or cultural twist. One of my favorites is a Thai-style sweet potato with sweet chili, toasted peanuts, and fresh cilantro.

SFC Foley: Shrimp cocktail. It's normally here at the DFAC's on Thanksgiving but rarely seen at home.

4. Do you have any holiday traditions or specific foods that you incorporate into JBER's Thanksgiving menu? Chef Eric: Green bean casserole has always been a favorite of mine, as well as

Chef Eric: Green bean casserole has always been a favorite of mine, as well as stuffing. Both are like the glue that hold a good Thanksgiving meal together. I am looking forward to "Pumping up" those items on the menu, Hanz and Franz style.

SFC Foley: I like to stick to the originals that people love.

5. Are there any dishes that are "must-haves" for the Thanksgiving meal?

Chef Eric: The roast turkey is going to be off the hook, juicy, and delicious. Don't worry though, we'll have you covered if you stop in late.

SFC Foley: Turkey, mashed potatoes, mac and cheese, ham, and collard greens.

6. What is YOUR favorite Thanksgiving dish?

Chef Eric: Pumpkin Cheesecake (New York Style) with an IPA Caramel sauce.

SFC Foley: Turducken!

7. Will you share how to cook the perfect turkey?

Chef Eric: I've tried just about every way you can imagine; brined, smoked, fried, sous vide, but my favorite is spatchcocked turkey. Make yourself a herb butter, tuck it in between the skin and the meat, toss it on a bed of aromatics and root vegetables. It will cook in half the time, and you'll have it all crispy and juicy.

SFC Foley: I brine mine for 24 hours and then fry it.

What's Thanksgiving without a little controversy? We asked our chefs this bonus question to spark a little controversy, but would love to have your answers as well.

Chef Eric: Fresh cranberry sauce every time! I love being able to customize the sweet-tart balance of my sauce with crystallized ginger and orange zest.

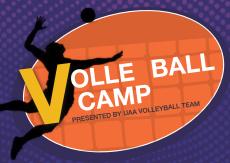
