

As October's chill settles in and the nights grow longer, the far reaches of America's Last Frontier beckon the bravest of souls to embark on an eerie adventure like no other. If you're looking to embrace the spirit of Halloween, pack your courage and set out on this spine-tingling road trip to some of Alaska's most haunted locales, all accessible from Anchorage.

The Historic Anchorage Hotel, Downtown Anchorage

Begin your journey in the heart of Anchorage at the Historic Anchorage Hotel. Though it may seem inviting, many guests report unexplained phenomena whispers in the night, the ethereal apparition of a young girl in the hallway, and the mysterious spirit of the city's first police chief, Jack Sturgus. He met his end just steps away from the hotel in 1921, and rumor has it he still patrols the premises.

The Begich, Boggs Visitor Center, Portage Glacier

As you depart Anchorage, set your sights on Portage. The Begich, Boggs Visitor Center is a testament to the ever-changing Alaskan landscape. It is a bustling hub for visitors wanting to glimpse the oncemajestic Portage Glacier. But it's not just the vanishing glacier that sends shivers down one's spine; visitors speak of haunting echoes from the tragic 1964 earthquake. Phantom voices murmur in deserted corners, and ghostly footsteps reverberate through the empty corridors. Some claim spectral apparitions dance over the dwindling glacier's waters, adding an air of melancholy and mystery.

Nike Missile Site Summit, Arctic Valley

Just up the road from Fort Richardson, the silent remnants of the Nike Missile

Base loom. A relic of the Cold War, this abandoned fortress is said to echo with ghostly alarms and phantom soldiers. Although it once stood as a rampart against Soviet threats, visitors now report eerie sensations of being watched. As you tread its grounds, feel the weight of history and, perhaps, the unseen gaze of its spectral guardians. Dare to explore, but remember: here, the past might peer back.

The Golden North Hotel, Skagway


A bit off the direct path, but well worth the detour, the Golden North Hotel in Skagway holds its fair share of ghostly tales. The most famous involves a young woman named Mary, who awaited her fiancé's return from a gold prospecting expedition. Legend has it that she died of pneumonia, but her spirit, still awaiting her lover's return, can be seen wandering the halls.

Red Onion Saloon, Skagway

End your haunted tour in the town of Skagway at the Red Onion Saloon. Once a brothel during the Gold Rush days, visitors claim to have encountered the spirit of a former madam, Lydia. Her presence is often accompanied by the scent of her perfume, and some even say they've felt her tap them on the shoulder.

As you traverse the frosty roads of Alaska, embraced by the haunting beauty of its landscapes, remember: in these parts, the living and the dead coexist. 


