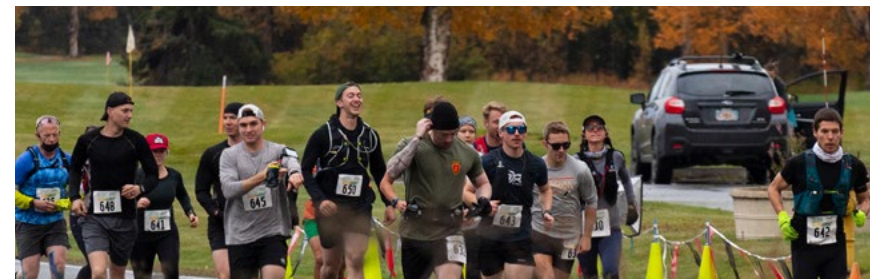

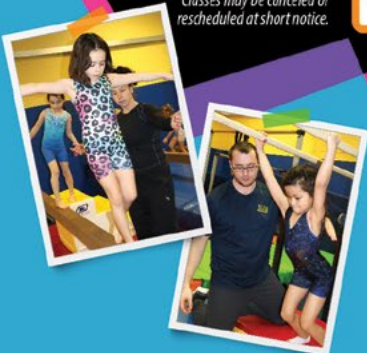

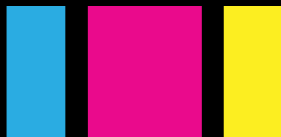

What is your role?

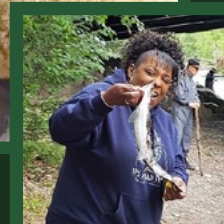
