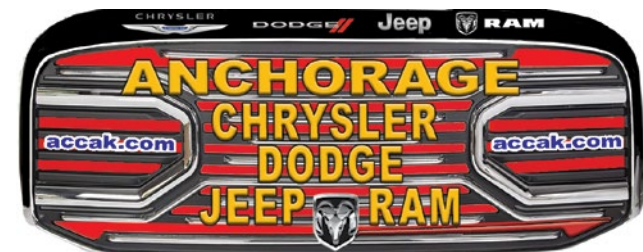



People of JBER

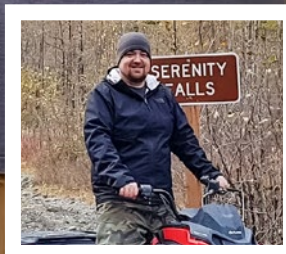

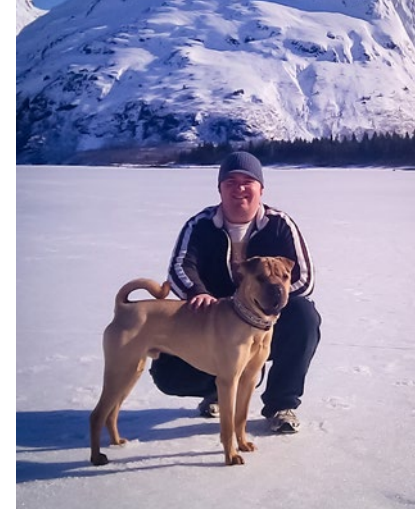

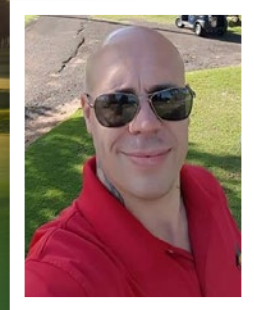
